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Bordeaux En-Primeur Offer 2015 Vintage

Without any doubt the top level of Bordeaux is one of the greatest wines to cellar. The elegance, freshness, perfume and concentration the wines hold onto over 10 to 40 (or longer) years is without compare. But you do have to wait for them, you do have to have a good cellar and most importantly you do have to buy from a good year.

Why should you buy 2015?

Great Bordeaux is still very much dependant on the vintage. The weather conditions in Bordeaux for the most part were agreeable albiet everything happened quite early. All the quality factors were there and the wines at the en-primeur tastings brought on a lot of excitement with some people comparing it to the 1998, 2005, 2009 and 2010 vintages for quality.

The pricing is fair for these wines compared to quality.

Why should you buy En-Primeur?

Two reasons: The pricing on En-Primeur is well in your favour. The great wines are at a risk of selling out.

What to buy.

Stick to classic producers who never fail to make thrilling wines. I would avoid the Second labels this year because the grapes that were good enough went into the Grand Vin.

The TWD Picks on the order form are a very good start. They are all wines that are true to style, offer value and have the ability to reward aging.

The Cabernet dominant left bank wines are elegant and will age well.

The right bank Merlot heavy wines (St-Emilion and Pomerol) are fresh and charming.

Sweet wines are having quite a purple patch and they will be lovely now or with age.

How does En-Primeur work?

It is important to know that the wines aren't finished yet. A sample that is indicative of each wine was offered for tasting earlier in the year (for those that made the pilgrimage to Bordeaux). The reviews from multiple sources are widely available.

Eventually the wines will finish maturing and be blended, bottled and branded. The wines should be ready to distribute in Australia from mid to late 2017.

If you buy wine off this offer you get the advantage of great pricing. Unless there is a massive change to the Wine Equalisation Tax you will not have to pay any more for the wines.

Once they arrive you may have to pay freight depending on the wine's final destination.
