Northern Medoc had a blinder. There is a lot to love there. The plateau of St-Emilion performed well and will offer beautiful wines.

There are a few lesser known estates that have made a great fist of the conditions and will be great value for lovers of Bordeaux.

While the whites aren't producing the vintage of the century they will provide ripe and aromatic drinking with soft acids.

Compared to the last few releases the sweet Bordeaux this is a step back. Delicious but not as complex or concentrated. There is a lot of pleasure on offer and sooner drinking though. Stick to the great estates.

The TWD Picks on the order form are the perfect place to start your search. They are all wines that I believe are true to style, offer value and have the ability to reward aging. They are the wines I will buy for myself.

How does En-Primeur work?

It is important to know that the wines aren't finished yet. A sample that is indicative of each wine was offered for tasting earlier in the year (for those that made the pilgrimage to Bordeaux). The reviews from multiple sources are widely available.

Eventually the wines will finish maturing and be blended, bottled and branded. The wines should be ready to distribute in Australia from mid to late 2017.

If you buy wine off this offer you get the advantage of great pricing. Unless there is a massive change to the Wine Equalisation Tax you will not have to pay any more for the wines.

Once they arrive you may have to pay freight depending on the wine's final destination.
